We write with regard to the request for a month-long extension for the Jones Library Expansion and Renovation Project in Amherst. As we understand it, the requested extension to April 30, 2025 will allow for the final negotiations and necessary paperwork between the Massachusetts Historical Commission, the Town, and the Library on the final Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and the inclusion of this MOA in the review by the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), which is required by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to secure the federal funding for this project. This work is necessary in order for the project to receive its federal funding before signing a contract with a general contractor and starting construction.
